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Master's Academy Announces Launch of Prestigious C.S. Lewis Honors Program for High School Students

Dr. Rick Brewer, Head of School at Master's Academy, emphasized the program's transformative nature, stating, "This initiative reflects our unwavering commitment to developing students who think deeply, lead boldly, and stand firmly on biblical truth. By integrating faith with rigorous academics, we are preparing the next generation of Christian leaders to engage with today's most pressing cultural issues."

A key component of the program is its interdisciplinary seminars, where students explore topics such as faith and reason through the writings of C.S. Lewis, ethical leadership through a biblical worldview, and the integration of theology, political science, and literary analysis. These courses encourage students to examine contemporary issues through the lens of faith and defend their perspectives with logic and reason.

A highlight of the program is the Oxford & Ireland Tour, a two-week academic journey immersing students in the intellectual and spiritual heritage of C.S. Lewis. Students will visit The Kilns (Lewis's former home), Magdalen College, and the Bodleian Library at Oxford. Engaging in discussions with Christian scholars, participating in literary and theological explorations, and integrating their experiences into research assignments, students will gain invaluable insights that will further shape their academic and spiritual journeys.

Beyond academics, the C.S. Lewis Honors Program is dedicated to developing well-rounded, Christ-centered leaders. Students will engage in Socratic-style discussions on theology, ethics, and philosophy, study the works of influential

Christian thinkers such as C.S. Lewis, G.K. Chesterton, and Francis Schaeffer, and receive apologetics training to defend their faith in today's ever-changing world. Leadership development opportunities include mentorship from faculty and community professionals, service-learning projects, and participation in national academic competitions, providing hands-on experiences that prepare them for college and adulthood.

To ensure students are well-prepared for their future, the program also provides college and career readiness resources, including college application and scholarship workshops, internship opportunities with Christian organizations, and a senior colloquium to equip students for university-level discourse. Graduates will be honored with a C.S. Lewis Honors Medal and a special diploma designation, recognizing their dedication to academic excellence, faith, and leadership.

Upper School Principal, **Kim Gillette**, underscored the significance of this program, stating, "By launching the C.S. Lewis Honors Program, we are investing in students who will stand firm in their faith, lead with wisdom, and engage culture with conviction. We are excited to witness the profound impact these young scholars will have in their communities and beyond."
